

Easy Pin Cushion



Knitting gauge: 7 stitches in 2 inches

Knitting Needles: size 7 needles

Yarn: Hand spun doubles (worsted weight) wool, approximately 45 yards.



Other supplies: One measuring cup from large bottle of laundry detergent.

Feel free to substitute the yarn of your choice. You may need to customize the width or length of the finished

fabric. Enjoy experimenting!

Basic Instructions:

Cast on 8 stitches, and begin garter stitch with a slipped stitch garter edging. The edging instructions are in the video on this web site <http://theknittingyarn.com>.

Make a slipped stitch along one edge (top), and change colors along the other edge (bottom).

Knit 10 inches of garter stitch. Fit the roll into the bottom of the measuring cup to be sure it fits snugly. Bind off 3 stitches on the edge opposite the slipped stitch. Then continue garter stitch with the slipped stitch edging on 5 stitches for another 6-1/4 inches. Bind off the remaining stitches.



Break yarn and fasten edge.

I fit the roll into the cup as I worked. I didn't weave in any ends, just tucked them into the roll.



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
